Range Resources

Pad development of a second well site has begun in the Township. The well site is located off of Deerfield Road. Drilling is tentatively scheduled to begin in November 2011. The well site on Alamae Lakes is back in operation but should be complete by August.

Consol Energy

Consol has been coal mining in the Southwestern portion of the Township near Pleasant Grove Road and operations will be steadily moving North along Route 221. In other news, the Township is assisting Consol fix a recurring problem along Old Post Road in which a portion of the road slipped downhill causing damage to the hillside and roadway. The road should be reopened by August.

Act 537 Plan

This Summer, representatives from Bankson Engineering, hired by the Township, will be surveying parts of the Township to establish a needs assessment that will be part of an Act 537 Plan. This Plan is the necessary beginning step to bring public sewage to the Township.

Franklin Manor Summer Projects

Bankson Engineering is again working with the Township to rehabilitate damaged sewage pipes in Franklin Manor. The pipes will be cleaned of debris then specially lined to seal cracks and breaks in the pipes. After completion of this project, Gateway Engineering has set-up a road reconstruction project for a portion of Annuity Drive. This is the first phase of a larger project to address the deteriorating conditions of Manor roads.

Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance

The Township is undertaking a joint project with Green Hills Borough to update our Zoning and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinances. The current Ordinances are very outdated and need to be redeveloped to accommodate potential growth within the Township and surrounding areas. Mackin Engineering has been hired to update the Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance. Notifications of public meetings will be advertised in the Observer-Reporter and at the Township building.

Township Recycling

The Township is actively exploring opportunities to provide recycling to all residents. Until that comes to fruition, Greene Arc, located at 197 Dunn Station Road in Prosperity, is a good option for disposing recyclable items such as: #1 and #2 plastics, cans, green, brown and clear glass, cardboard, newspaper, magazines and junk mail, including glossy paper.
