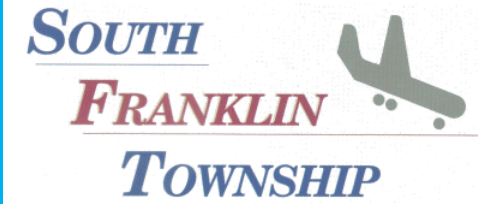
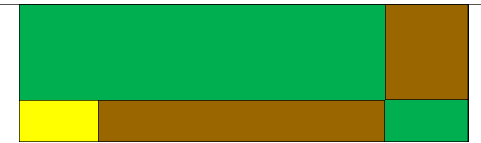

Range Resources

Range Resources has completed the horizontal drilling stage of the Folly Hollow well site located on Deerfield Road. Fracking is not scheduled to begin until Spring 2013. The Township continues to work with Range to ensure the safety of residents and to correct any problems that arise from the drilling activity. If you have any concerns or questions regarding drilling operations, please contact Township Manager Tyler Linck so the Township can take remedial action, if necessary.

CNX Gas

CNX Gas has five (5) well sites located in the Township. Three on Farmer Lane, one on Old Scales Road and one on Bethel Church Road. A sixth site is being proposed near the intersection of Route 221 and Pleasant Grove Road. The Township is working closely with CNX to ensure the safety of our residents and durability of our roads. All roads will be rehabilitated once drilling is completed. CNX has constructed two water impoundments and pipelines to service all sites.

Upcoming Projects

Bankson Engineering is working hard on completing our Act 537 Plan in hopes of bringing public sewage to the Township. We hope to have this Plan completed this year. Another project is upgrading the Equalization Tank in the Franklin Manor Sewage Treatment Plant to ensure the plant continues to operate efficiently and properly. The Township also plans to reconstruct other concrete roads in Franklin Manor as well as fresh asphalt overlays beginning this Spring. Finally, the municipal building, picnic tables and playground equipment will receive some touch-up paint to complete an on-going painting project.

Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance

The Township is undertaking a joint project with Green Hills to update our Zoning and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinances. Mackin Engineering was hired to complete the update of the Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance. The draft ordinances are available at the Township building and online. Please submit any comments to the Township as soon as possible so they can be discussed and if necessary, incorporated into the ordinances. The Zoning Hearing for potential adoption will be April 2 at 6:15 pm.

Electronics Recycling
