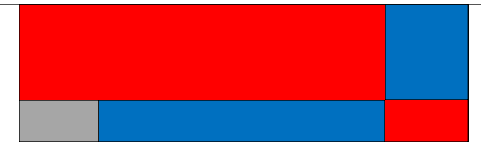

Parks & Recreation

Electronics Recycling

South Franklin Township is offering free recycling of specified electronics and appliances. A list of acceptable items for recycling is available online or upon request. Call the Township when you are ready to deliver the recyclables.

Township Dumping

The ever popular “dump site” on the Bedillion S curve has been roped off by CNX, owners of the property, and dumping will not be tolerated. Individuals caught dumping will be prosecuted. This also goes for anyone caught illegally dumping anywhere in the Township.

Range Resources

Range Resources has completed all major operations on the Folly Hollow well site located on Deerfield Road. The Township will continue to work with Range to ensure the safety of residents and to correct any problems that arise from future activity. Please contact the Township if any problems arise.

CNX Gas

CNX Gas has five (5) well sites located in the Township. Three on Farmer Lane, one on Old Scales Road and one on Bethel Church Road. A sixth site has been developed near the intersection of Route 221 and Pleasant Grove Road for research and data collection only. A seventh site is being constructed off Gameland Road but the site will be in East Finley. CNX will also be constructing a water fill station on Route 221 near the Morris Township border. It will be a coin operated facility open to everyone. The Township is working closely with CNX to ensure the safety of our residents.

2014 Pavilion and Building Rental Info

South Franklin will start taking reservations for 2014 rentals of the Community Building and Pavilion for South Franklin Township residents only beginning Thursday, January 9, 2014 at 8:30 AM at the municipal building (Now with Cable TV access. Ask us how!). Residents must apply in person and pay the deposit (Bldg. \$100 and pavilion \$125) when the reservation is made. Beginning March 1, 2014 reservations will be open publicly.

Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance

The Township has undertaken a joint project with Green Hills to update our Zoning and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinances. Mackin Engineering was hired to complete the update of the Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance. The new ordinances have been adopted and enacted as of May 7, 2013.

Upcoming Projects

Bankson Engineering is working hard on completing our Act 537 Plan in hopes of bringing public sewage to the Township within the next few years. Another project is upgrading the Equalization Tank in the Franklin Manor Sewage Treatment Plant to ensure the plant continues to operate efficiently and properly. This project should begin in December 2013.
