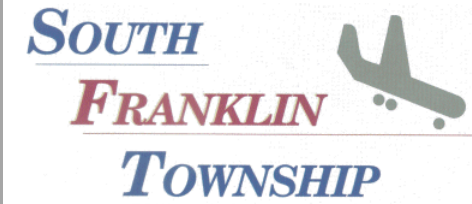
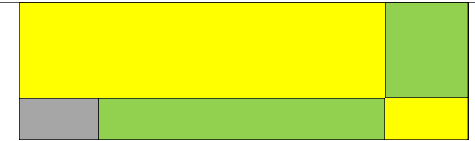

# Township Bulletin

## Parks & Recreation

On March 15th, the Township Park Board and McGuffey East Youth Baseball organization is held their annual St. Patrick's Day Adult Night Out. The Easter Egg Hunt will be held on April 12th at 10:00am with a makeup date of April 19th at 10:00am. As for projects this year, new fencing will be erected for the Walker Lane fields and also a new concession stand. The Township will be pursuing funding opportunities to further upgrade all of the playground equipment and potentially build a pavilion for the upper portion of the park. Also, the Park Board is looking for a new member to fill a vacancy. Please contact the Township if interested in joining.

## Local Share Account

In 2013 the Township submitted an application to the Local Share Account for funding to construct permanent restroom facilities for the Township Park. A double restroom facility will be placed near the lower pavilion, and a single restroom facility will be constructed for the top two ball fields, if funded.

## Electronics Recycling

## Upcoming Projects

Bankson Engineering is working hard on completing our Act 537 Plan in hopes of bringing public sewage to the Township within the next few years. Also, the Equalization Tank in the Franklin Manor Sewage Treatment Plant is being replaced to ensure the plant continues to operate efficiently and properly. This project began on January 27th and should run about 90 days until completion. Also, portions of Estate Lane, Bond Street and Dividend Drive will be reconstructed this year. The project will begin in early spring and should last no longer than two weeks. More information will be provided before the project is officially underway. Tar & chipping will be completed the second and third week of July.

## CNX Gas

CNX Gas has seven (7) well sites located in the Township. Three on Farmer Lane, one on Old Scales Road, one on Bethel Church Road, one on Gameland, and one on Pleasant Grove Road which is for research and data collection only. The Township is working closely with CNX to ensure the safety of our residents.
