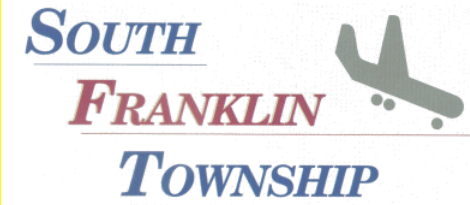
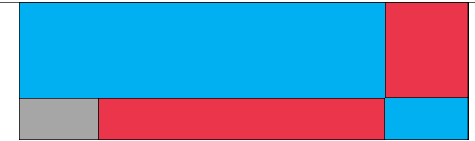

Parks & Recreation

The Township is beginning the process to develop a Park Master Site Plan which will detail the Park and how the Township can further develop its amenities. Once this is concluded, the Township will pursue funding opportunities to upgrade the playground equipment and other park facilities. In order to efficiently update the park, we will be needing YOUR help as well. Please visit the Township's website and fill out our survey!

Local Share Account

In October 2013 the Township submitted an application to the Local Share Account for funding to construct permanent restroom facilities for the Township Park. The Township has officially received the grant and will begin starting the project process. A double restroom facility will be placed near the lower pavilion, and a single restroom facility will be constructed for the top two ball fields. This project will be completed in the Fall of 2014.

Electronics Recycling

Ongoing & Upcoming Projects

Bankson Engineering is working hard on completing our Act 537 Plan in hopes of bringing public sewage to the Township within the next few years. We will have the first draft in July. The Equalization Tank in the Franklin Manor Sewage Treatment Plant has been replaced to ensure the plant continues to operate efficiently and properly. This project was completed on June 13. Also, portions of Estate Lane, Bond Street and Dividend Drive in Franklin Manor have been reconstructed this year. The road project will continue next year. Also, the Township's section of Bells Lake Road will be reconstructed. Lastly, tar & chipping will be completed the second and third week of July in the Township.

CNX Gas

CNX Gas has seven (7) well sites located in the Township. Three on Farmer Lane, one on Old Scales Road, one on Bethel Church Road, one on Gameland Road, and one on Pleasant Grove Road which is for research and data collection only. The Township is working closely with CNX to ensure the safety of our residents.
