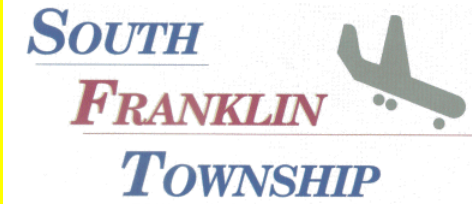
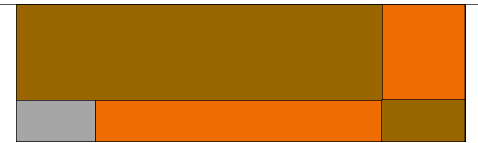

Parks & Recreation

The Township is in the process of determining to develop a Park Master Site Plan which will detail the Park and how the Township can further develop its amenities. Once this is concluded, the Township will pursue funding opportunities to upgrade the playground equipment and other park facilities. Lastly, on October 25th, the Appalachian Bicycle Racing Association will be holding their second race event in the Township. Check our website for details.

Local Share Account

In October 2013 the Township submitted an application to the Local Share Account for funding to construct permanent restroom facilities for the Township Park. A double restroom facility will be placed near the lower pavilion. This project will be completed in the Fall of 2014. For the 2015 LSA, South Franklin is applying for funding for an additional permanent restroom facility that will be placed near the top two fields in the main Park. The application for this project is due on October 15.

Electronics Recycling

South Franklin Township is offering free recycling of specified electronics and appliances. A list of acceptable items for recycling is available [online](#) or upon request. Call the Township when you are ready to deliver the recyclables.

Ongoing & Upcoming Projects

Bankson Engineering is working hard on completing our Act 537 Plan in hopes of bringing public sewage to the Township within the next few years. The draft plan is currently being reviewed by the state Department of Environmental Protection. We're hoping in 2015 to apply for funding to get the project started. Tar & chipping was completed the second and third week of July in the Township and we are currently performing ditch correction operations throughout the Township. The Township also completed a project at the intersection of Old Plank and Route 18 in hopes of alleviating the water ponding and icing issue we have been experiencing in the winter.

CNX Gas

CNX Gas has seven (7) well sites located in the Township. Three on Farmer Lane, one on Old Scales Road, one on Bethel Church Road, one on Gameland Road, and one on Pleasant Grove Road which is for research and data collection only. The Township is working closely with CNX to ensure the safety of our residents.
