Parks & Recreation

The Township has developed a Park Master Site Drawing that details the Park and how the Township can further develop its amenities. A public meeting will be held soon to discuss the new drawing and future plans for the Park. In line with the new drawing and plans, new playground equipment has been installed at the main Township Park and down at Walker Lane. We plan to continue updating the amenities and facilities of the Park throughout the coming years. Come play today!

Local Share Account

In October 2013 the Township submitted an application to the Local Share Account (LSA) for funding to construct permanent restroom facilities for the Township Park. A double restroom facility has been constructed near the lower pavilion. In October 2014, the Township submitted another application to build a new pavilion for the upper level of the Park. This project will begin in September 2015.

Electronics Recycling

Ongoing & Upcoming Projects

Bankson Engineering has completed our Act 537 Plan in hopes of bringing public sewage to the Township within the next few years. The Plan is currently under Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection review. Once we get approval from PADEP we can then move forward with applying for funding for the project. The entire Plan is available for resident review at the Township building if you are interested in learning more.

CNX Gas

CNX Gas has seven (7) well sites located in the Township. Three on Farmer Lane, one on Old Scales Road, one on Bethel Church Road, one on Gameland Road, and one on Pleasant Grove Road which is for research and data collection only. The Township is working closely with CNX to ensure the safety of our residents.
