The Township has developed a Park Master Site Drawing that details the Park and how the Township can further develop its amenities. In line with the new drawing and plans, new playground equipment has been installed at the main Township Park and down at Walker Lane. In 2016 the Township will be applying for grant funding to construct more trails within the Park. We also plan to continue updating the amenities and facilities of the Park throughout the coming years. Come play today!

Local Share Account

With \$50,000 from the LSA the Township was able to construct a new \$51,000 pavilion for the upper level of the main Township Park. It will be open to all in Spring 2016. This pavilion is now available for rent for \$125.

Upcoming Projects

In 2016, the Township will be undertaking various projects that include but are not limited to: finishing the Franklin Manor Road Project, constructing a new parking lot for the upper pavilion, and tarring and chipping will begin in July. Roads will include Alamae Lakes, Old Post, Deerfield, Old Scales, Old Plank, Hiawatha, Folly Hollow, Verner, Grandview, and Bethel Church.
