

ORDINANCE NO. 3-1978

PROHIBITING PARKING OF VEHICLES ON
TOWNSHIP ROADS OR HIGHWAYS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of South Franklin Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1:

No person shall park or leave standing any motor vehicle on the paved and/or traveled portion of any Township Road or Highway.

SECTION 2:

The Township shall have the power and right to remove any vehicle parked in violation of this Ordinance, and to assess the costs of such removal to the owner of said vehicle.

SECTION 3:

Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions hereof shall, for each and every violation, be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00 for each offense, with costs of prosecution. In default of payment of the fine and costs, offender may be imprisoned in the County Jail for a period not exceeding ten (10) days.

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after adoption.
