Act 537 Sewage Plan

South Franklin Township finally has an approved public sewage Plan! The Township received a \$500,000 grant from the LSA for Phase I permitting and design. Then we can apply for construction grants and loans in Summer 2019 to actually build the facilities. Bankson Engineering is working on the final design of the project. Groundbreaking is expected in early 2020. The Plan and Project Map are available at the Township Office for anyone to review.
