Where to donate blood during COVID-19 restrictions

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, many schools, places of worship and businesses that had blood drives scheduled had to cancel. This resulted in a loss of 60 percent of the blood we collect for patients in area hospitals.

You can help by donating at one of our 10 donation centers in the greater Pittsburgh area, and at community blood drives in neighboring West Virginia and Ohio communities.

IMPORTANT: Blood donation is a safe, essential health care activity, and is permitted during stay-at-home orders.

To make an appointment at a donation center visit vitalant.org/donatebloodPA or call 412.209.7000.

To find a blood drive near you:

- Visit donateblood.centralbloodbank.org.
- Click on “Donor login,” “Create Login” or “New Donor.”
- Follow the prompts to get to the Appointment Scheduling page.
- Scroll down to **Search for Nearby Drives**.
- Enter your zip code and distance willing to travel, then click the **Search** button.
- If nothing shows up, there are no drives near you in the upcoming month. You can expand your distance or date range and try again.
- Click on desired drive to highlight it, then click **Select** button below the list.
- Find an available appointment slot on the list, click to highlight it, then follow the prompts to schedule your appointment.
