AGENDA: Matt Keith, Kim Keith and Edgar Bedwell presented information on their proposed Maple Hill housing development seeking confirmation of either Option #1: allowing for 40 of the 59 homes to be built on grinder pumps and pressure sewers or Option #2: constructing an entirely new pump station and installing gravity lines all down the property and then flow to Franklin Manor. Option #1 cost is approx. \$132,000 extra, Option #2 is over \$1,000,000 plus an additional yearly maintenance cost to the Township at approx. \$30,000. Township engineers are Bankson are still awaiting final flow data analysis of the current Franklin Manor Sewage Treatment Plant but have approved Option #1 pending that analysis and completion and acceptance of the planning module needed for the subdivision.
