Motion by Leibhart to participate with the Co-op on a joint bid for road oil and stone. The bid should include 32,000 gallons of CRS-2 (E-3) road oil, 5,000 gallons of CNTT for Fog Seal, 300 tons of #67, 900 tons of #8, 100 ton of AASHTO #1, 120 tons of R-6 rip rap, 25,708 SY asphalt surface treatment - in place, to consist of washed #67 aggregate for 1st layer and washed #8 aggregate for second layer (CRS (E-3) emulsion shall be used), 59,373 SY asphalt single seal coat - in place washed #8 aggregate (CRS (E-3) emulsion shall be used), 31,362 SY CNTT for Fog Seal application. The Township agrees to pay a portion of the advertisement costs, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Gadani. Motion carried 2-0.
